Mission Statement

With God as our shelter and Christ as our guide, the mission of St Bernard's Preparatory School is to educate towards love and service to God, each other and the wider community. The effective date of this Agreement is when You accept it in accordance with the procedure set out below. You hereby consent to the exchange of information and documents between Us electronically over the internet and/or by email.

Your access to this website is subject to legally binding terms and conditions. Please take the time to carefully read all of the following terms of use. Accessing this website is the equivalent of your signature and indicates that you accept the terms and conditions and that You intend to be legally bound by them. If You do not agree with these terms and conditions, please leave the site immediately.

1. Ownership and copyright
