Dear Parents/Carers

It has been brought to my attention that our parents are not being kind to each other in the car park. Parents need to be role models to each other and respect one another. I ask you all to behave accordingly and to remember to adhere to the code of conduct for our school car park.

- At all times please consider carefully the safety of our children when parking or driving in the car park or the vicinity of our school.
- At all times please be courteous and consider the needs of other road users in the car park or the vicinity of our school.
- Please observe the Road Traffic Regulations in the vicinity of our school;
- 1. Please comply with the 5 mph speed limit.
- 2. Ensure children are supervised in and around the car park at all times.
- 3. Put pedestrians first when manoeuvring in the car park.
- 4. Give way to school minibuses
- 5. Please report any accidents to the school office immediately.
- Please park within the clearly marked bays within the confines of our school car park. If the bays are full, please find alternative parking outside the school gates.
- Please be considerate when using the car park and do not cause unnecessary obstruction to other users.
- Please consider whether it is necessary for you to park on our school car park- ask yourself, could the space you are occupying be better served by those with a greater need, e.g. childminders or parents with pre-school children/buggies.
- Do not obstruct access to disabled parking bays or prevent emergency vehicle access to the confines of the school. With this in mind:
- Supervise your child/children closely at the front of school.

Homework Club and After School Clubs

In order to ease pick up from Homework Club and some other After School Clubs we are trialling a few changes in order to make life easier for both parents and children. These changes will take place from Monday 27th January. Please see below for details.

Lower School Homework Club – Early Years, Year 1 and Year 2

Lower School Homework Club will always be in the Upper Prep (Year 2) classrooms. If you are collecting mid-session, please go to the Year 2 classrooms via the front door. Please wait at the classroom door and a member of staff will bring your child to you. The children who stay for the whole session will be dismissed from the front door as normal at 4.45pm.

Upper School Homework Club – Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6

Upper School Homework Club will always be in the Upper Trans (Year 5) classrooms. If you are collecting mid-session, please collect your children from the external door from Mrs Verma's room. The side gate adjacent to the Music Room will be left unlocked but should not be left open. The children who stay for the whole session will be dismissed from Mrs Verma's external door at 4.45pm. Any late children will be brought to the front of school at 4.50pm.

If you are collecting from both Upper and Lower School Homework Club please collect the youngest child first and then proceed back through the front door and around the outside of the building to collect the older sibling.

Ballet and Street Dance (Monday and Wednesday)

If your child attends the 3.30-4.00pm Street Dance or Ballet Session please collect from the Year 2 classroom at 4.00pm (for children not staying for the remaining Homework Club session). The children attending the 4.00pm-4.45pm Street Dance and Ballet Sessions will be dismissed from the front door at 4.45pm as normal. Parents are not permitted to wait in the corridor outside the Hall and must wait until 4.00pm before collecting.

I do hope these more consistent arrangements will make collecting your child or children easier. We will review these new collection arrangements over the next few weeks in order to ensure they are working smoothly.
