During Advent we have an Advent Wreath made in the shape of a circle and of evergreen leaves to remind us that God's love is like a circle and never ends. It reminds us that, in God there is no beginning and no end. He is the Eternal and Ever Living God. The wreath is decorated with three purple candles and one pink, representing the prophets, Abraham, Moses, David and John the Baptist. The fifth, white candle is in the centre and represents Jesus, the Light of the World, who first shone on Christmas Day.
