**DRAMATICA CLASSES FROM SEPTEMBER 2023  
ST BERNARD'S PREPARATORY SCHOOL**

Following our incredibly successful first year at St Bernard's, we are very excited to announce details of all our clubs from September 2023.

These are the sessions we will be running from September 2023. ***Please note, spaces are strictly limited and are offered on a first come first served basis. These sessions are run by practitioners from the Dramatica Team.***

**GROUP LAMDA: YEARS 1-3\***

**Tuesday Lunchtime break**

**£5.50/session**

Children will work on building their confidence within a group and interaction with their peers. They will work on a variety of material which will be used as their examination work at the end of the summer term. This includes poetry and stories, as well as devised work. Other skills include speaking, listening, sharing, self expression, presenting and performing. There will be limited lines to learn during the course and we ask that parents support their children in this.

Children will take an exam in front of an external examiner and be awarded a certificate. These exams are OFQUAL regulated meaning those that continue to study towards them at the highest level will gain accreditations that may be used towards the UCAS tariff.

**GROUP LAMDA: YEARS 5&6\***

**Tuesday after school, 3.40 – 4.45pm**

**£7.50/session**

Children will work on a variety of performance skills and in small groups and to produce a piece of work ready for the examination in the summer term. This will involve learning scripts, working on characters, staging and directing. Children are also given the opportunity of performing at one of the major theatres in Windsor which is arranged independently from St Bernard's. The LAMDA exams are designed to promote confidence and interpersonal skills, as well as looking at speaking, script work, movement, character, roleplay and improvisation. There will be lines to learn during the course and we ask that parents support their children in this.

Children will take an exam in front of an external examiner and be awarded a certificate. These exams are OFQUAL regulated meaning those that continue to study towards them at the highest level will gain accreditations that may be used towards the UCAS tariff.

**NEW: DEBATING AND PUBLIC SPEAKING: YEARS 4-6**

**Thursdays lunchtime break**

**£5.50/session**

Students will look at the skills involved in speaking in public and presenting their ideas to an audience. They will be encouraged to debate both sides of an argument and work on sounding confident when speaking to a group.

**NEW: INTRODUCTION TO DRAMA: EARLY YEARS**

**Thursdays after school, 3.30 – 4.00pm**

**£5.50/session**

Children are introduced to working together and encouraged to speak in a way that promotes confidence and communication skills. Children work from stimulus stories to capture their imaginations and see where it takes them. There will take part in a variety of activities, including storytelling, role playing, singing and dancing with the focus being on building confidence. Children are always encouraged to share their work within the group and gain important listening skills.

**NEW: FUNTIME DRAMA: YEARS 1, 2, 4**

**Thursdays after school, 4.00 – 4.45pm**

**£6.50/session**

Children will spend the sessions learning various skills, including acting, singing and dancing. There will be the opportunity to work towards informal performances throughout the year to parents. Children are encouraged to share their ideas and enjoy performing.

**YEARS 1-6**

**Tuesdays & Thursdays during the school day**

**£20 per 30 minute session**

These sessions work on a weekly individual peripatetic basis with an average of 8 sessions per term and 24 over the year. Children have the option of working on a choice of subjects including Public Speaking, Acting, Verse & Prose, Musical Theatre and Shakespeare. The timetable is provided on a rotational basis, with breaktimes usually being reserved for those in Year 6. These sessions are also particularly useful to those undergoing interviews and scholarships for next schools.

The students take an exam in the summer term in front of an external examiner. Students are given the opportunity of performing at one of the major theatres in Windsor, arranged independently from St Bernard's.

Children will take an exam in front of an external examiner and be awarded a certificate. These exams are OFQUAL regulated meaning those that continue to study towards them at the highest level will gain accreditations that may be used towards the UCAS tariff.
