Programme Details

- Offered to Years 1-6
- Dates - Weds 9th Sept- 15th Oct & Weds 4th Nov- 9th Dec
- Wednesdays
- 3:45pm–4:45pm (Full 60-minute session)
- Maximum of 15 per class (can go to 20 if receiving help from the school)
- Investment: £12.50 per child, per twelve week programme £150 investment in total
- If popular could look at a second class

Full One-Hour Sessions

Each session lasts a full 60 minutes, allowing children to complete a different pottery project every week with individual guidance and plenty of time to enjoy the creative process.

Skills Children Will Learn

Once basic paint and colour techniques are mastered, we can move on to other skills including

- Colour blending,
- layering, sponging,
- stencilling,
- bubble effects,
- silhouette painting,

- pattern design and
- personalisation

We will work at the pace of the group to ensure each pupil has the opportunity to try each skill.
